- Monroe County
  - \$19 million water main improvement going well
- Northwest Water & Sewer District
  - New elevated tank being painted – hope to be in service soon
  - Peloton building – contractor has completed “box.” A lot of interest in it.
  - First Solar working on second phase; more phases coming
  - Crossroads Rossford looking at more development
  - Last phase of master plan almost complete
- Toledo
  - CIP is primarily going on now
  - With Waterville dropping out, we are having some issues (THMs) going to Whitehouse
  - Will email memo on treatment issues to everyone
  - Rate study subcommittee – numbers passed out
  - Will provide numbers in advance (2 weeks) from here on out
  - Fulton County Service Area – Toledo City Council approved additions to Fulton County service area
  - Continue to replace meters; beginning in early June will begin replacing residential meters
- Perrysburg
  - Adding front line staff
  - Water tower painting project under way; new logo
  - Continue to negotiate with Northwest Water & Sewer District re: water and sewer
- Sylvania
  - Water mains being replaced
  - Pumping station inspection study upcoming
  - Water foreman just retired
  - Solar data collection units being changed to electric

- Embarking into CityWorks
- Sewer project – no bidders (timing issue)
- Fulton County
  - Delta connecting to Fulton County water
  - Swan Creek Water District 1 & 2 merging to one
  - Northeast Water System – repairing old waterlines in Assumption and Metamora and in early stages of looking at design project to help minimize some water inefficiencies
  - Fulton Lucas pump station upgrades submitted to EPA
